## FEATURES OF THE GIS VIEWER

Icon	Name	Description

• v Point	Point	Add a point to the map. You can also access additional drawing tools (text, line, ellipse, circle, polygon and rectangle).

You can obtain the following information from the GIS Viewer:

- KiwiRail's property boundary or landholding identified by the black or red lines on the map. Boundaries shown with a broken (dashed) line are not (or only partially) survey accurate.
- Locations such as station names and railway line name and kilometrage.
- Identify public and private level crossings.
- Structures such as bridges and tunnels.
- Land Information New Zealand address and land parcel information.
